

Kiss & Ride - Sailors Bay Rd Afternoon Rules of Conduct

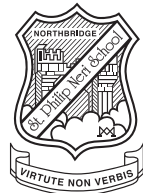
Do This:

- Do go around the block if all spots are occupied.
- Do obey 40km per hour speed limits and all NSW road rules.
- Do use the roundabout further down Sailors Bay Road to turn around.
- Do remain in your vehicle at all times.
- Do apply your handbrake when in the Kiss & Ride zone.
- Do follow instructions of teachers.
- Do be a happy, safe and considerate Kiss & Ride advocate.

Not This:

- Do not obstruct traffic flow by waiting for a spot – go around the block.
- Do not block the presbetry driveway or park in the school driveway.
- Do not double park or overtake.
- Do not undertake any U-turns in close proximity to the school.
- Do not be inconsiderate of other parents or risk our childrens saftey.

Please note, Kiss & Ride is a privilege not a right. If you are a repeat offender your children may lose the right to join the Kiss & Ride line after school.



Kiss & Ride Morning Rules of Conduct

Do This:

- Do move to the front of the queue where room permits.
- Do go around the block if there is no room.
- Do be a happy, safe and considerate Kiss & Ride advocate.

Not This:

- Do not obstruct traffic flow by waiting for a spot – go around the block.
- Do not double park.
- Do not block resident driveways.
- Do not leave your car unattended but you are welcome to get out of the car to assist your children with bags.
- Do not be inconsiderate of other parents or risk our childrens saftey.
